4. Cleanup of area undertaken

ISSUES

1. BOMBING/VANDALISM

- SEVERAL INSTANCES OVER THE PERIOD
- TAGS QUICKLY REMOVED BY NCC RAPID RESPONSE TEAM OR PAINTED OVER BY AEROSOL ART TEAM
- REPORTING PROTOCOL DEVELOPED BETWEEN RAPID RESPONSE TEAM AND YOUTH VENUE TO IDENTIFY AND DETER TAGS AND VANDALISM

2. COLLABORATION

- **CO-OPERATION BETWEEN RAPID RESPONSE TEAM AND AEROSOL ARTISTS**
- **REFERENCE GROUP CONSENSUS REFLECTS THAT COLLABORATION**
 - **OF PARTICULAR NOTE IS THE WAY THE AEROSOL ART COMMUNITY HAVE CLAIMED “OWNERSHIP” OF THE AGREEMENT.**

3. AEROSOL ART CONTRIBUTION

- **56 aerosol artists have registered as users of the South Newcastle Beach area**
- **Approximately 25 young people have contributed to the creation of community murals**
- **The creation of the Seniors Wall has encouraged a collaborative approach to the development of Senior murals**
