ASBESTOS? Don't Risk It!

Newcastle City Council recommends you:

- treat all fibro sheets as if they contain asbestos unless tested.
- use a licensed asbestos removal contractor to remove all materials containing asbestos.

These recommendations are enforced on all development approvals issued by Newcastle City Council.

HOW DO I ENSURE THE SAFE DISPOSAL OF ASBESTOS WASTE MATERIALS?

Council Requirements for the Disposal of Asbestos

For the safe disposal of asbestos ensure you:

- > keep all waste containing asbestos wet;
- > do not put asbestos waste in domestic garbage bins and compactors;
- > collect and store asbestos fibre and dust waste in impermeable bags which:
 - * are made of heavy-duty low-density polyethylene at least 0.2mm thick, at least 1.2m high and 0.9m wide;
 - * are sealed with wire ties;
 - * are no more than 25kg in weight;
- > if the waste is stored in sealed bags:
 - * the bag must be kept in a leak-proof container used only for the purposes of storing asbestos waste;
 - * the container must have a close-fitting cover to prevent any spillage or dispersal of the waste;
- > each bag should be clearly labelled 'Caution-Asbestos Waste' in letters of not less than 40mm;
- > the container in which the asbestos waste bags are kept should be clearly labelled 'Danger - Asbestos Waste Only - Avoid Creating Dust' in letters of not less than 50mm;
- > the waste should be stored in a secure area to prevent the risk of unauthorised entry and environmental harm and be stored separate from other wastes;
- > stabilised asbestos should be disposed of and unloaded in a manner that reduces the creation of dust. Each sheet should be wetted and the wetted bundles wrapped and sealed in heavy duty plastic as stated above;
- > all waste should be removed from the site as soon as possible in a covered leak proof vehicle to prevent any spills or dispersal of waste and be disposed of at an approved asbestos disposal facility;
- > the vehicle used to transport the asbestos waste must be cleaned to remove all residual asbestos waste before leaving the disposal site.

Please be aware that any waste material that contains asbestos, is classed as asbestos waste and therefore must be handled as asbestos waste.

Legislation Relating to Asbestos Waste

Clause 29 of the Protection of the Environment Operations (Waste) Regulation, 1996 makes it an offence not to comply with the special requirements relating to the transportation, collection, storage or disposal of asbestos waste, regardless of whether the activity is required to be licensed. The maximum penalty for not complying with the Clause is \$100,000 for individuals and \$200,000 for corporations.
