

Driveway Line Marking Application

Council can arrange for driveway line marking to be installed if you are experiencing unacceptable and continuing encroachments on access to your property. This will eliminate unnecessary No Parking signs on either side of the driveway. The line marking is in accordance with Sections 138, 142 and 218 of the Roads Act 1993. The applicable charge for lines on either side of the driveway is **\$127.10** (inclusive of GST). An application is only available for a Council approved driveway crossing.

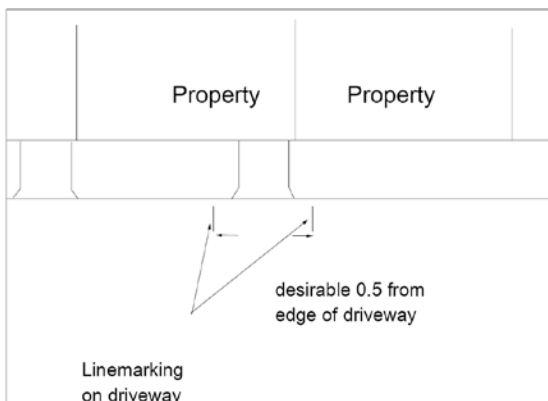
