#### 3.1. Economic Briefing

Dr Anthea Bill, HRFC UON presented an update on economic insights (copy at **Attachment A**).

#### 4.1. Economic Development Strategy (EDS)

CN's Economic Strategy & Government Relations Manager presented an update on the development of the EDS (copy at **Attachment B**).

Council report seeking approval to exhibit draft EDS scheduled for 23 February 2021.

Highlights – partnership approach. Acknowledge TAFE. International – English as a second language completed a workshop with CN. Often an overlooked sector.

Youth also engaged.

Proposed that S&I committee continue to provide a governance role with advisory input. Standing agenda item to provide updates.

New Local is the foundational framework for the EDS. New Local representative gave a presentation (**Attachment C**).

Information on successful superfunds case studies: <u>Nova Scotia Securities Commission: Community Economic-Development Investment Funds</u> and <u>Farmworks Investment Co-operative Limited</u>.

#### 4.2. Destination Management Plan (DMP)

CN's Tourism Manager presented an update on the DMP approved at the 24 November 2020 Council Meeting for public exhibition (copy at **Attachment D**).

The leisure market has the greatest growth opportunity for the Newcastle visitor economy.

The committee discussed the development of the international tourism market and 'one stop shop' for information on Tourism opportunities and best examples.

#### 4.3. Strategic Advocacy

CN's Economic Strategy & Government Relations Manager gave an update on the achievements of the City Taskforce.
