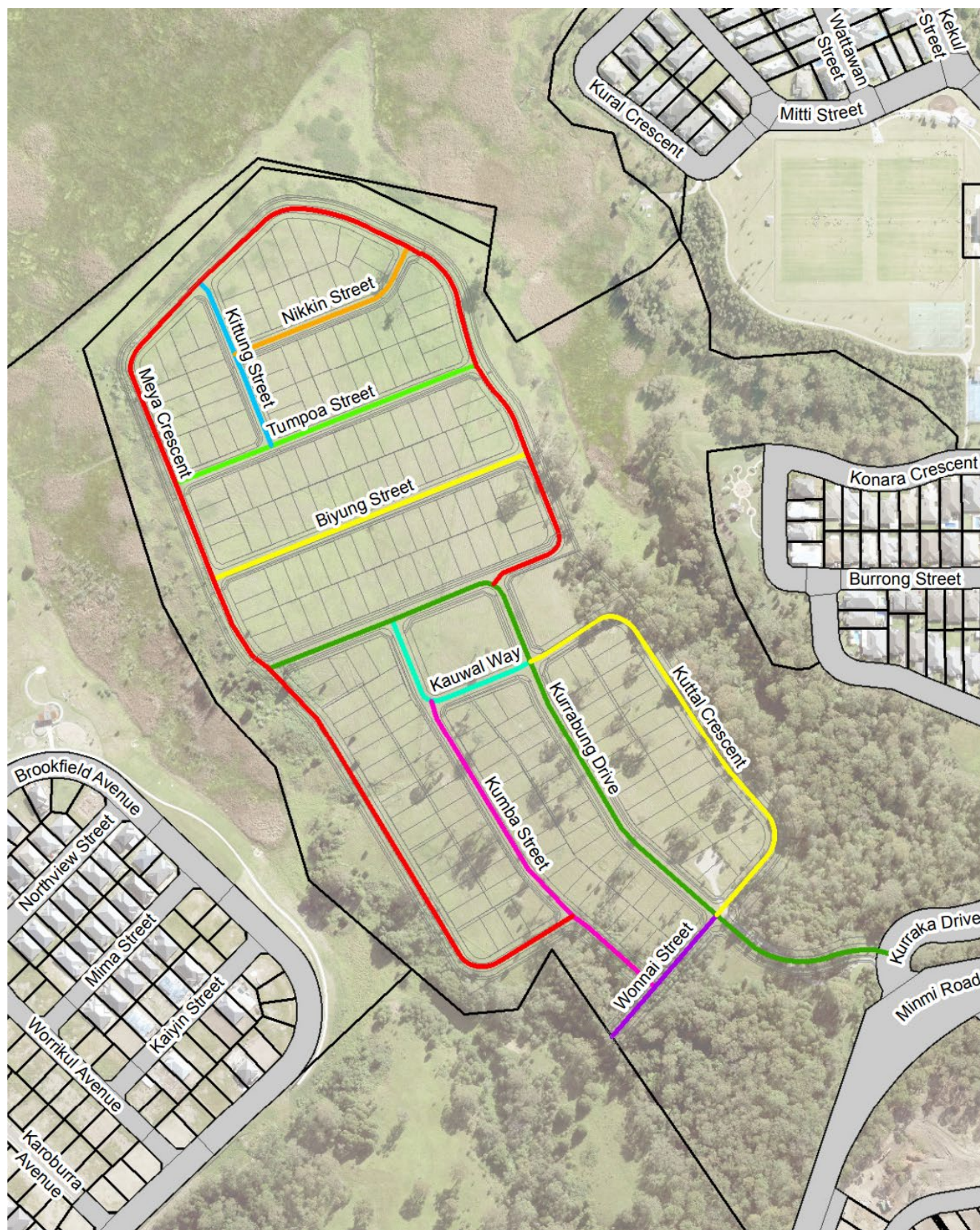
Exhibition

City of Newcastle is formalising road names for ten (10) roads in Fletcher. These road names have been approved by the Geographical Names Board and are currently in use. City of Newcastle is placing the names on public notice and inviting submissions from the public prior to publication in the NSW Government Gazette.

These roads have been named to facilitate addressing to aid emergency service location and service delivery. Please see the below table and attached location map (Attachment 1):

	Road Name	Name Origin	Extent Description
1.	Kurrabung Drive	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning the body	Extends North-west from Kurraka Drive, Fletcher to Meya Crescent
2.	Kumba Street	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning tomorrow	Extends North-west from Wonnai Street to Kauwal Way
3.	Kittung Street	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning hair of the head	Extends South from Meya Crescent to Tumpoa Street
4.	Kauwal Way	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning great	Short street which extends from and returns to Kurrabung Drive, also intersecting with Kumba Street
5.	Biyung Street	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning father	Extends from and returns to Meya Crescent
6.	Wonnai Street	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning child	Extends South-west from Kurrabung Drive to the boundary of the Sanctuary Estate, also joining to Kumba Street
7.	Tumpoa Street	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning clay	Extends from and returns to Meya Crescent, also intersecting Kittung Street
8.	Nikkin Street	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning coal	Extends West from Meya Crescent to Kittung Street
9.	Meya Crescent	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning sinews	Extends from Kumba Street around the proximity of the subdivision to rejoin Kurrabung Drive
10.	Kuttal Crescent	Local Indigenous Language (Awabakal) - meaning the smoke of a fire	Extends from and returns to Kurrabung Drive

Submissions

- the grounds of objection (if any);
- quote 'Fletcher Road Naming – 2021' in the title of the submission; and
