

SELECTION CRITERIA

PURPOSE OF THE COMMUNITY AND CULTURE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

To provide advice and guidance on the development of strategies, and identification of challenges and opportunities, in relation to cultural planning and heritage, arts and cultural opportunities, community pride and local identity including local history, and community involvement which encourages a sense of belonging within the LGA.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Professional experience in planning and promoting community and cultural programs or local heritage and history.
2. Demonstrated interest and understanding of policies and strategies that arts, culture, heritage and learning organisations require to provide integrated community services and optimal outcomes for the community.
3. Connections or networks with established community and stakeholder cultural, heritage and arts groups in City of Newcastle.

Applicants must submit a statement of no more than two pages outlining how they meet the selection criteria and how this relates to the purpose of the committee.
