
SELECTION CRITERIA

PURPOSE OF THE LIVEABLE CITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

To provide advice and guidance on the development of strategies, and identification of challenges and opportunities, in relation to urban planning, heritage, safety, affordable housing and healthy and connected urban systems within the LGA.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Demonstrated interest and passion for community and stakeholder involvement to improve Newcastle as a Liveable City.
2. Professional experience or expertise in one or more of the following: heritage, urban planning, place making, sustainability, community engagement, urban design and related fields.
3. Connections or networks with established formal or informal community and stakeholder networks in Newcastle.

Applicants must submit a statement of no more than two pages outlining how they meet the selection criteria and how this relates to the purpose of the committee.
