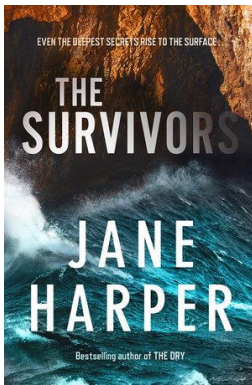


The survivors by Jane Harper
