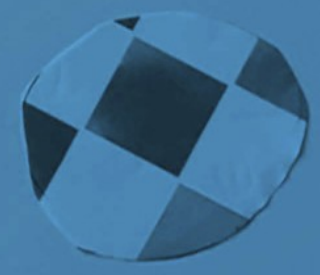

Paper chain creations – What can you create?

What you need

- Paper (any paper will do)
- scissors
- Glue, tape or stapler

What to do

- Cut strips of paper
- Tape, glue or staple the end of one strip together to form a loop
- Insert a second strip of paper into the loop
- Tape, glue or staple this strip to form an interconnecting loop
- Continue until desired length is reached
- Add multiple loops to one loop to form chains in different directions.
- Create different effects by using different colours and textures of paper, or use a hole punch to create different patterns.
- Paper chains can be very versatile as Christmas or party decorations
- Paper chains can also be used to create art.
- Draw and glue on accessories such as faces hands and feet etc
- Use your imagination and CREATE something AMAZING.
