


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

Background

Accessibility and safety improvements are proposed for the existing children's crossing next to Waratah Public school on Bridge Street. An upgrade intends to address the lack of kerb ramps and the stepped kerb on the residential side of the crossing. Changes are also proposed to increase visibility for drivers of pedestrians at the crossing.

The proposal to upgrade the crossing to a raised pedestrian crossing was given support to undertake community consultation by the Newcastle City Traffic Committee on 21 October 2019.

This consultation is being undertaken to ensure that the community is informed and has the opportunity to raise any concerns prior to reporting to Council for approval.

We are seeking feedback on a proposal to replace the children's crossing on Bridge Street near Boomerang Road, Waratah with a raised pedestrian crossing.



What is proposed

We are seeking feedback on a proposal to improve pedestrian safety in your neighbourhood by constructing a raised crossing outside Waratah Public School on Bridge Street, near Boomerang Road.

Works include:


- Construction of a raised pedestrian crossing on Bridge Street near Boomerang Road
- Construction of kerb extensions at the raised pedestrian crossing, including rain gardens
- Upgrade of street lighting to meet Australian Standards
- Signage and line marking

A range of upgrades are proposed at this crossing.

There will be a moderate increase in parking availability associated with the works, with parking restrictions adjusted to suit the upgraded infrastructure.
